QUALIFICATIONS

- **A.** (a) Cambridge School Certificate with credits in at least five subjects including English Language, French, Mathematics or Principles of Accounts and a science or technical subject obtained at not more than two sittings or
 - **(b)** Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, French, Mathematics or Principles of Accounts and a science or technical subject obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject.

NOTE 1

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at "Principal Level" and one subject at "Subsidiary Level" as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

- **B.** A Cambridge Higher School Certificate <u>or</u> Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level".
- **C.** A Certificate pitched at Level 4 on the National Qualifications Framework in the relevant field from a recognized institution.

<u>OR</u>

Equivalent qualifications to A, B and C above acceptable to the Board of the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development.

NOTE 2

"In the absence of qualified candidates, by selection from among candidates who possess:

- **A.** A Cambridge School Certificate or Passes obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Ordinary Level" either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject.
- B. A Certificate in the relevant fields from a recognised institution.

Equivalent qualifications to "A" and "B" above acceptable the Board of the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development.

C. At least five years' post qualification experience in the relevant field.

NOTE 3

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR DRIVING (PRIVATE CAR AND MOTORCYCLE)

Private Car: Candidates should also possess a valid driving license for the related vehicle and a Driving Instructor's License for motorcar issued by the Traffic Branch over and above the qualifications listed above.

Motorcycle: Candidates should also possess a Driving Instructor's License for Motorcycle issued by the Traffic Branch over and above the qualifications listed above.

DUTIES

- 1. To be responsible for the vocational training of apprentices, unskilled workers and adult industrial workers in the relevant trades.
- 2. To assist in the laying out, installation, putting into operation and maintenance of equipment of a workshop/section, computing of lists of tools, equipment, raw materials and requisitioning same for conducting training and to render any other assistance as required.
- 3. To prepare and/or adapt training programmes, syllabi, tests, examinations, standards and implement same.
- 4. To prepare the written instructional materials and audio-visual aids.
- 5. To teach up to National Certificate Level 3 and/or National Certificate Level 4, give shop talks, demonstrations and conduct assessments and trade tests.
- 6. To assist in the recruitment of trainees.
- 7. To ensure discipline among trainees and security measures in class/workshop.
- 8. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
- 9. To perform such other duties related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from incumbents in the roles ascribed to him.

REMUNERATION

The successful candidates will be paid an all-inclusive fee ranging from **Rs 450/-** to **Rs 600/-** per contact hour which will commensurate with qualifications, experience and the level of course they will be required to dispense.

EQUIVALENCE OF QUALIFICATION
